


# How to Turn Off Compatibility View

---

We have upgraded our website to be more compatible with Internet Explorer 9 and 10. In order for these changes to take place, compatibility mode should be disabled. If you see the error below, then you will need to disable compatibility view.



## Internet Explorer 9 & 10

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Press the **Alt** key to display the Menu bar (or right-click the Address bar and then select **Menu bar**).
3. Click **Tools**, and then click **Compatibility View Settings**
4. Click **hubgroup.com** under **Websites you've added to Compatibility View**
5. Uncheck **Display all websites in Compatibility View** (if applicable)

## Internet Explorer 8

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Press the **Alt** key to display the Menu bar (or right-click the Address bar and then select **Menu bar**).
3. Click **Tools**, and then click **Compatibility View Settings**
4. Click **hubgroup.com** under **Websites you've added to Compatibility View**
5. Uncheck **Display all websites in Compatibility View** (if applicable)
